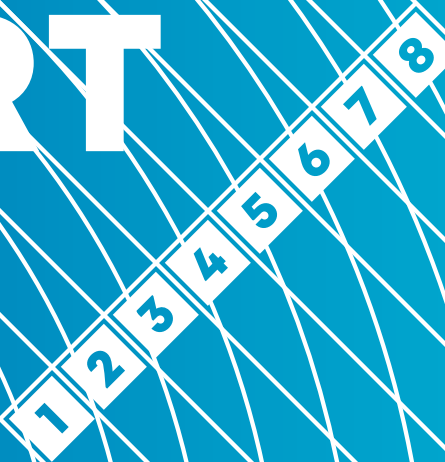


WHERE TO GO FOR SPORT IN BRNO?

A sports-leisure facility where visitors can experience active recreation in the form of a 25-metre fitness pool, a relaxation pool, a fitness centre and a massage parlour. In the relaxation pool visitors can experience water jets, waterspouts, a waterfall and a toboggan. To relax tired muscles, the Jacuzzi, steam bath and Finnish sauna can help. 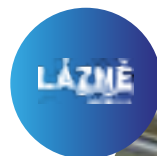

LUŽÁNKY CITY SWIMMING STADIUM

“The only covered 50-metre pool in Brno”



The swimming stadium offers a 50-metre pool with a diving

tower and diving boards for professional sportspeople.

The recreation pool with a water temperature as high as 34°C is ideal for

younger children and for those who want a bit of a rest after swimming. The pleasant Aquabar is accessible from both the wet and dry areas of the pools.

As part of the Lužánky City Swimming Stadium, a new wellness centre has been constructed. This can be used by both visitors to the existing pool (a steam bath with showers) and individually as an additional payment zone, which includes steam cabins, a bio sauna, Finnish sauna, experiential showers, a cooling bucket and a whirlpool. A cooling pool with a leisure area is located on the existing west terrace.

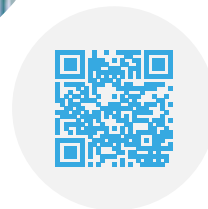

“Relaxation and fitness swimming in the centre of Brno”

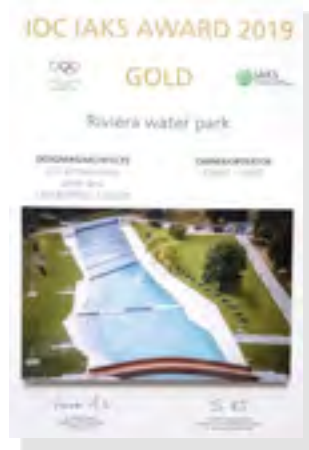
The Ponávka swimming pool is with its dispositions ideal for fitness swimming for individuals and organised groups. It is a 25-metre pool divided into 3 tracks. A steam bath and a separate rear area of changing rooms for men and women is part of the pool. The premises serve predominantly to the general public, however they can be rented by sports clubs at certain times. Exercise lessons for seniors and aqua aerobics are also organised here.

RIVIERA WATER PARK

“The largest swimming pool premises in Brno”

Riviéra consists of a cascade of three new stainless steel pools of varying depths, a waterslide and waterspouts, which are complemented by extensive grassy rest areas. Children get to enhance their experience with new water amusements – a toboggan, waterslide, rope-bridge, climbing wall, climbing net, water mushroom and bucket tree. There are courts for beach volleyball, bouncy castles and a children’s playground at visitors’ disposal. The whole grounds of the swimming pools were acquired by the company STAREZ – SPORT, a. s. in 2006. From that point on they have tried to prepare something new and interesting for the recreation of the citizens of Brno every summer.

The Riviéra swimming pools were part of a large reconstruction effort in 2018, which consisted mainly of lining the unsatisfactory pool bottom with new stainless steel basins.

The children’s pool and paddling pool also got a makeover, having some new water amusements installed alongside the existing toboggan and slide. Further, the reconstruction included a complex reworking of the pool technology and revitalisation of the green areas with new plants and the creation of an irrigation system.

In 2019, Riviera water park became the winner of a golden certificate for architecture awarded by the International Olympic Committee and the International Association for Sports and Leisure Facilities in a competition of altogether 98 projects that represented all five continents of the world.

ZÁBRDOVICE SWIMMING POOLS

**“WAVES – a unique
amusement in Brno”**

The Zábrdovice swimming pool is a summer venue that operates between June and August. It offers visitors two 50-metre pools, one of which includes a unique wave generator that the lifeguards switch on at regular intervals. The visitors can also use the toboggan with a landing pool. Families with children will appreciate the paddling pool and the children's playground. When rest is needed, there are grassy areas and terraces above the pool level and the beach volleyball court is at the visitors' disposal for more active moments.

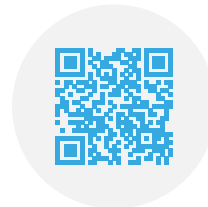
ZA LUŽÁNKAMI ICE RINK

A new ice rink for the public was opened in 2009 at the location of the former winter sports stadium. Shortly after, it was entrusted to the management of the company STAREZ – SPORT, a. s. The facilities of the ice rink include a stall with refreshments, lockers, toilets, a first aid station and a skate sharpening stall. In 2012, an ice skate rental stall was added to the facilities.

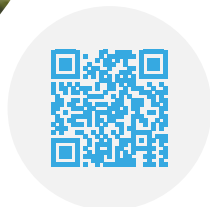

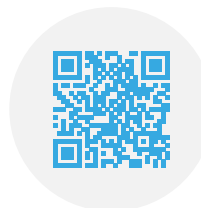
LUŽÁNKY SMALL FOOTBALL FIELD

The playing field for five-a-side football, measuring 48x28 metres, is prepared both for groups from the public and sports clubs or schools. The full dimensions of the artificial grass field are 56x34 metres. When the lighting is switched on the field is available even in later evening hours. The visitors can find the facilities, consisting of toilets and a dressing room, in the nearby building next to the mobile ice rink. TRAFFIC EDUCATION GROUNDS

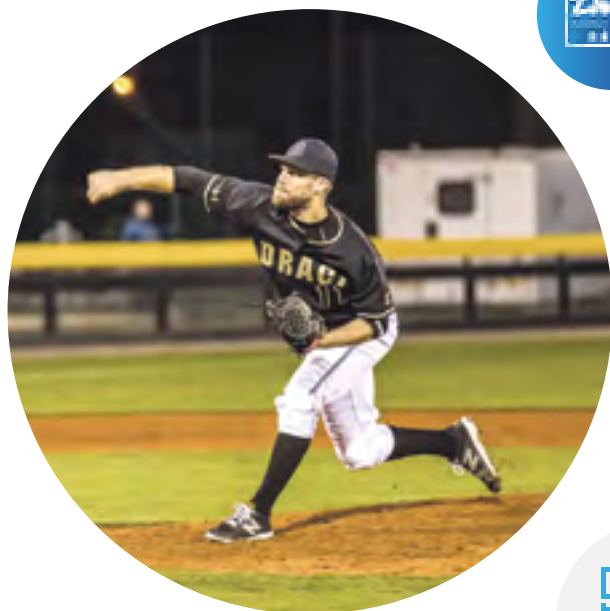
The traffic education grounds were opened to the public in October 2015. The partially covered field, operating throughout the year, is located in the northwest part of the leisure zone of the Riviéra swimming pools. A roller-skate track that follows on from a cycle trail around the Svratka river was created around the grounds. Apart from traffic education for children, the grounds serve the public, cyclists, seniors and the disabled. The programme for groups is dealt with by the grounds' operator – Brno Municipal Police.

CITY BASEBALL STADIUM

The city baseball stadium was built in 2007. It is located in the south of Brno, by the Svatka river in Brno-Komárov. It was one of the first sports fields in this area, where sports-recreation grounds were progressively created near the streets of Hněvkovského and Sokolova. Since its creation, it has been rented by the baseball team Draci Brno (Brno Dragons). Apart from local competitions, important international baseball events are also held here.

ZUBŘÍ RECREATION CENTRE

The grounds are located in the town of Zubří in a recreational area at the edge of the forest, northwest of Nové Město na Moravě. The entire grounds are driver friendly. In the grounds themselves, a natural pool with a slide, a tennis court with an artificial playing surface, a children's playground and sufficient parking space can be found. The full capacity of the centre is 114 beds.

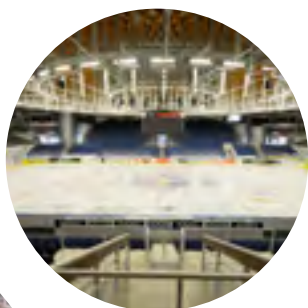
DRFG ARENA – HALA RONDO

The Rondo Sport Hall (DRFG Arena) is the largest multi-purpose hall in Brno, officially opened in 1982 and reconstructed in 2010. Hockey matches of the HC Kometa Brno club, various international sports events and cultural events are held here. Currently, the hall's capacity stands at 7 700 seats and is rented by the sports organisation KOMETA GROUP, a.s.

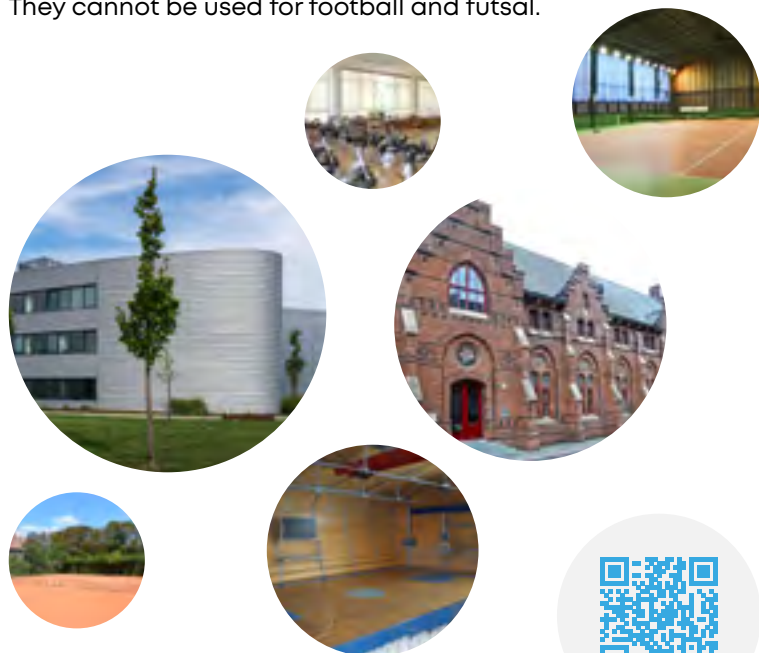

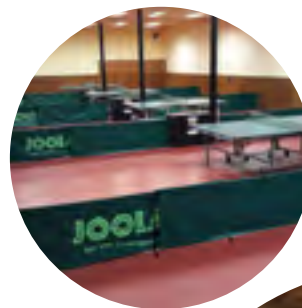


TABLE TENNIS HALL

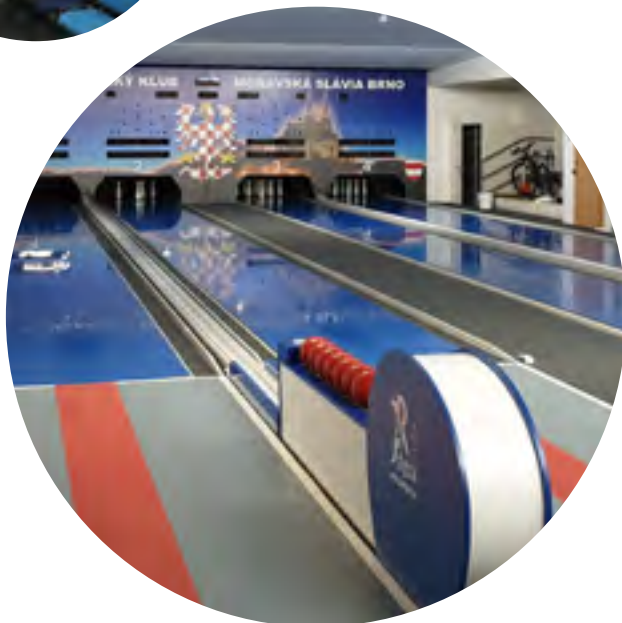
GYMNASTICS HALL

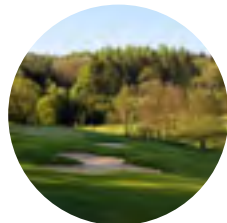
BRNO-DVORSKA HORSE-RACING TRACK

There are 2900 seats. Inside the grounds, there is also a small hall for ballgames, which has a one-level seating area with a capacity of 900 seats. The grounds include an outdoor ice rink and the venue also offers accommodation.

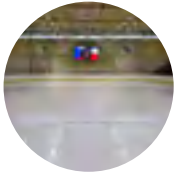


FIGURE SKATING HALL

SINGLETRAIL – MARIÁNSKÉ ÚDOLÍ

Single trails are narrow natural trails planned and made in accordance with a special proven methodology, thanks to which they are ideal for recreation in the countryside. The single trail is a one-way track for mountain bikes sensitively placed in the terrain on which you can really enjoy yourself. In Brno's Mariánské údolí you can choose from 3 circuits:

Single trails in the Mariánské údolí:

1st circuit:

Route length: 6 km

Route: Mariánské údolí base – Lávky – U jezevce – Pod kapličkou – Mariánské údolí base

2nd circuit:

Route length: 14 km

Route: Mariánské údolí base – Stoupací cesta – Vápenky – Mezi hájenkami – Březový – U Chlapečka – Palaška – Mariánské údolí base

3rd circuit:

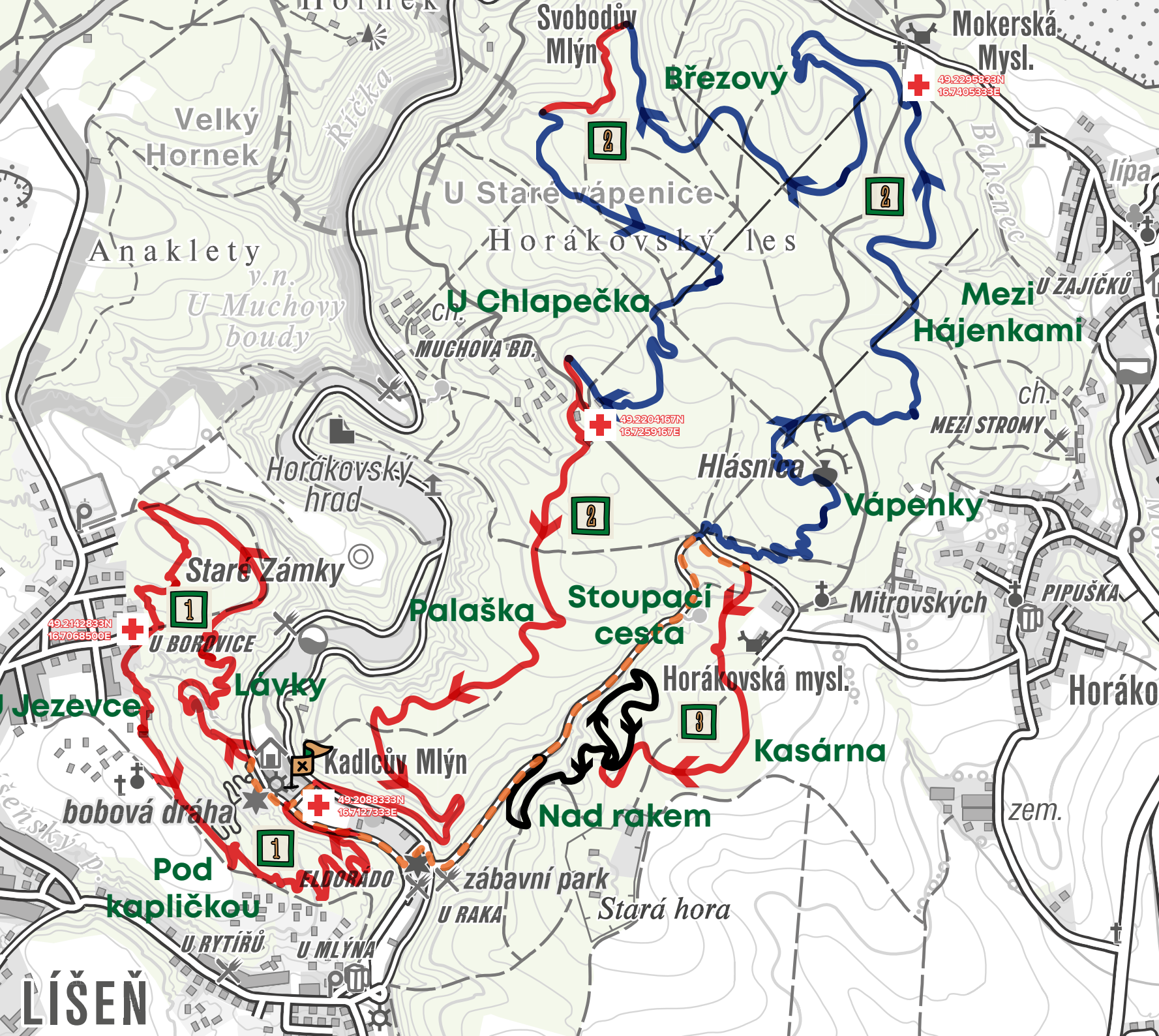
Route length: 6,5 km

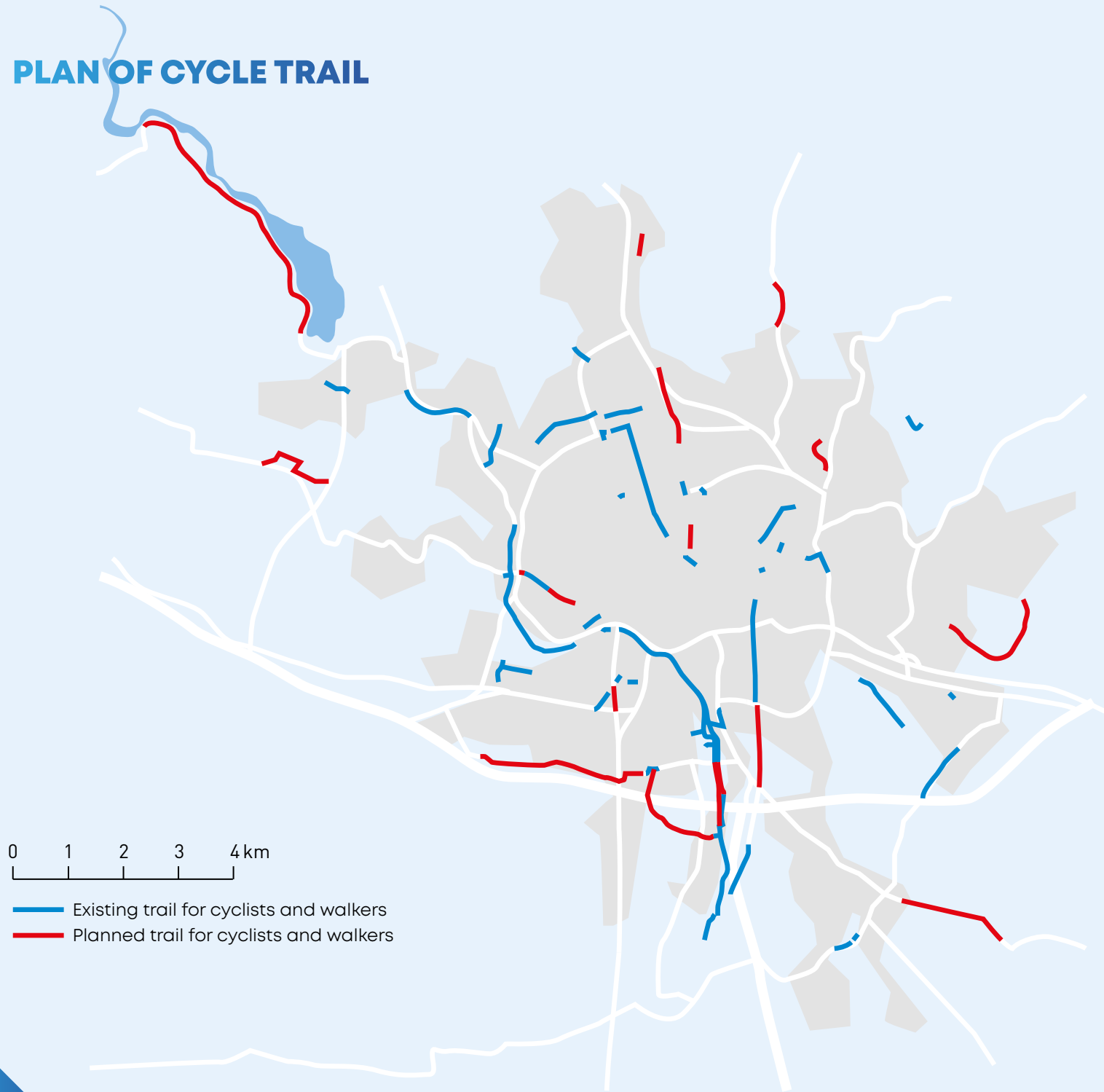

CYCLE TRAIL / BRNO RESERVOIR

This new cycle trail should be on the right bank of the Brno Reservoir in the stretch between Rakovec and Veverí Castle. In total the city will build 6 km of trail with a width of 3 m, including utilities, necessary retaining walls and culverts. The South Moravian Region started to prepare reconstruction road II/384 assuming a continuation of the preparation of projected routes from Veverí Castle toward Brno. There are three possible options for the final form of the bike trail. The two differ slightly in some sections. The third allows for a bridge over the reservoir.

CYCLE TRAIL / ŽEBĚTÍN – BYSTRC - KOHOUTOVICE

This comfortable route will newly take cyclists between Žebětín, the upper part Bystrc and Kohoutovice. It will link the communities of Holedná and Kohoutovice and thus the centre of Brno-Žebětín, the Kamechy settlement and the whole upper part of Bystrc. The trail ends at Holedná from where you can safely get to Bystrc or Kohoutovice. It will also use the old tunnel under the highway to pass below this busy road.

CYCLE TRAIL / VÍDEŇSKÁ

Brno intends to build another bike trail along Vídeňská street. A half-kilometre track will lead from the Renneská tram stop along Jihlavská street. Until now cyclists have had to particularly use pavements, which reduces the safety of pedestrians. For the safety of cyclists the road then at the critical point crosses over Vídeňská street at the Renneská tram bridge Renneska and narrows to two lanes. The crossing will be made safer by an 'island', to establish a cycle path parallel to the curb for tram rails.

CYCLE TRAIL / STRÁNSKÁ SKÁLA

The investment project for a cycle trail from Stránská skála to Holzova street in Líšeň has been approved. It should become the first step in connecting Líšeň and its surroundings with the centre of Brno for cyclists. People on bikes will also easily be able to go between Slatina peat and Líšeň. The planned cycle trail will be especially useful for those whose goal is the popular Stránská skála.

CYCLE TRAIL / ALONG THE LESKAVA STREAM

The planned bike trail will start where the Leskava stream crosses the road III / 15270. The first stage will lead to the intersection with Podsedky street. The second phase envisages the building of a bike trail from the end of district of Lány to the exit to Rajhradská street. Altogether, this will be about 1.6 kilometres. The bicycle path along the Leskava from the intersection of B. Němcové and Klobásova streets to the section where the stream flows into the Svatka also assumes general cycle route development measures.

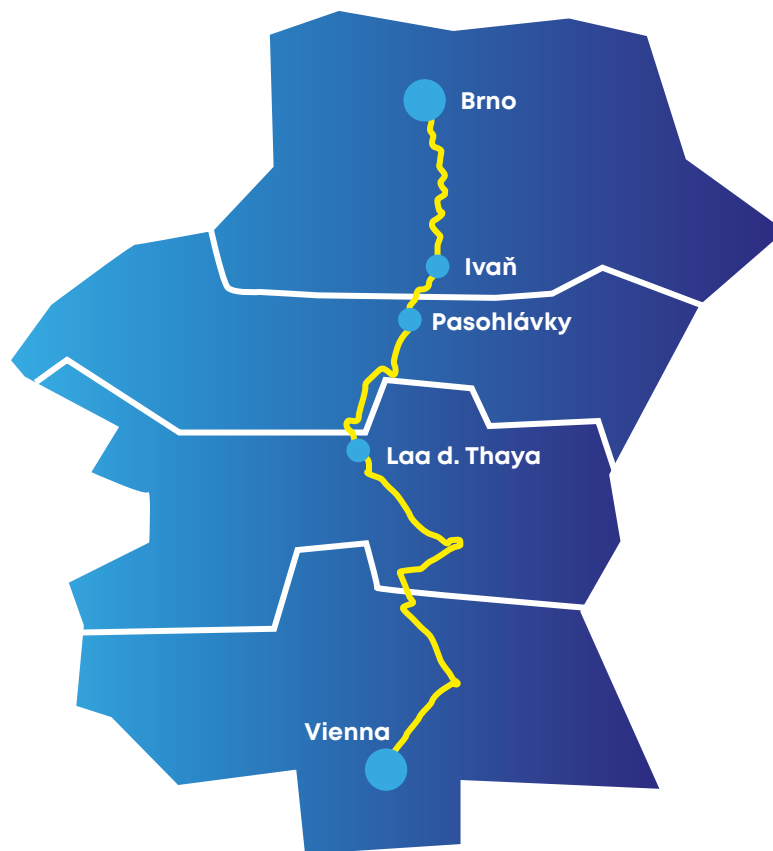
CARE FOR EXISTING CYCLE TRAILS

The city also cares for existing measures for cyclists. During May and June 2019 there was extensive renewal of traffic markings showing dedicated bicycle lanes on major streets in the localities of Kounicova, Mendlovo nám. and Svatopluka Čecha. The renovation and improvement of the visibility of signs was undertaken especially in the light of the summer cycling season, with particular regard to the safety of cyclists.

BRNO-VIENNA CYCLE TRAIL

The Brno-Vienna cycle path, which connects two important central European cities, goes mainly through the territory of South Moravia and Lower Austria's Weinviertel. Both neighbouring regions are famous for their vineyards and wine culture. With a variety of attractive destinations and moderate terrain it is ideal for cycling. The trail leads from Brno via Židlochovice, Pasohlávky and Nový Prerov to the border crossing of Hevlín/Laa an der Thaya, and further through Mistelbach to Vienna, nearly 170 km and is mostly on asphalt roads with minimal motor traffic. The bicycle route also includes five thematic circuits related to the spinal trail and linking it to points of interest in its surroundings.

The city of Brno for what is now the second year provided a grant to run 10 cyclobuses, which transported cyclists free of charge to places distant from Brno, such as Hevlín, Laa an der Thaya, Mistelbach and Vienna. Cyclobuses run on Saturdays, according to the terms on the website www.brnoviden.cz where there is the possibility of booking a cyclobus.

BRNO CITY PROJECTS

“RECRUITMENT” DAY

This is organised by the city association STAREZ-SPORT, a.s. in cooperation with the South Moravian Regional Organisation of the Czech Union of Sport with financial support from the city of Brno. They represent here in Brno sports clubs and other clubs from South Moravia.

In one place children can try out different sports activities. There are promotional materials and application forms for the clubs represented at this event. The project aims to motivate children in this way and get them interested in sport. On the site there are exhibits that show visitors a wide variety of physical activities. Boys and girls can try out each sport and based on that choose which they would like to pursue. For children and adults there is a rich accompanying programme involving sports legends and important personalities.



In 2018 the presented sports included, in addition to the best known and most widely played, such as football, tennis, hockey, athletics, swimming and basketball, many that most children encountered for the first time. One stand introduced for example windsurfing, while other young visitors learned about headis or korfbal and how handball differs from national handball. There were also winter sports such as skiing, biathlon and ice hockey. In 2018, the fourth year of the event was attended by nearly 6,500 people.

SPORTS GROUNDS DAYS



2018 marked the fourth year of this event held in 13 sports facilities in Brno. Throughout the three days there was a rich accompanying programme mainly for kids with financial support from the city of Brno. People were able to try for example Minigolf, a climbing wall or the ice-skating rink behind Lužánky, in most cases for free throughout the three days between Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve.

The aim of this event is to show visitors all the services offered at these sports sites and their equipment.

The main purpose of the event is to provide an opportunity to try out unusual sporting disciplines, such as paddleboarding or water ball or just to go for a swim between the holidays. At the same time we try to motivate children and introduce them to sports and a healthy lifestyle.

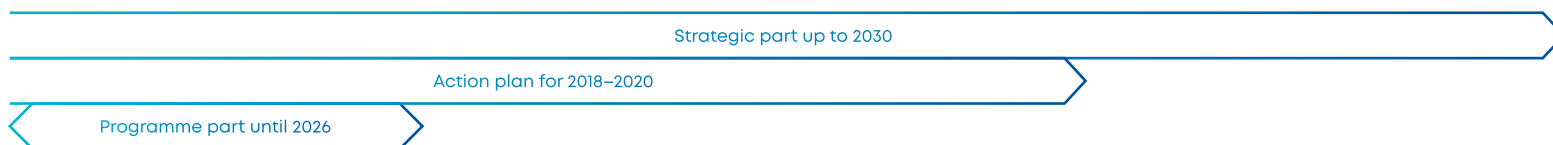

The Concept of the City of Brno in the field of physical education and sports, for example, addresses the funding of sport, dealing with the evaluation of the membership base, maps significant Brno sports and defines development projects for sport. It will proceed on this basis in the support for sports.

Each year the city of Brno, through public calls, writes programmes to promote sports and leisure activities in these areas:

Subsidies are also provided for year-round sports and sports activities, international competitions and major sporting events, as well as for the promotion of professional sport.

Stable funding for sport will be achieved within the specified long-term horizon of 2030 with a gradual increase in the percentage of expenditure allocated to sport from the total operating expenses of the city, as indicated in the table.

Support for sport at the level of the city of Brno is divided into several grant programmes. Criteria for the evaluation of applications and the conditions for granting subsidies are given in the individual calls. This distribution is planned for the future while it is possible for some programmes to be added or modified. Particular calls respond to legislation changes, the needs of sports organisations and subsidy programmes announced from other sources.

MULTIPURPOSE SPORTS AND CULTURAL PAVILION

In 2019 it was decided to set the construction of the multi-purpose sporting and cultural hall to the western part of the Brno Exhibition Centre. The hall will be designed not only for organising top sporting and cultural events, but also for everyday use, including youth sports.

The architecture and layout enables a very quick transition from sports hall to a cultural function, and thus gives the possibility of organising a number of cultural, social and corporate events, without significantly impairing the sports function of the hall.

VELODROME

Construction of the new premises will replace the current velodrome in Pisárky which no longer meets the quality requirements for the sport. The new velodrome is part of the “Planning Study for the Hněvkovského Locality,” which was drawn up in 2007.

The velodrome is designed to the parameters of the UCI international federation for organising international cycling competitions with a 250 m wooden track.



This will give it the character of the most modern sports facility of its kind, not only in the Czech Republic but also in Central Europe. It has the potential to be a training centre for preparing youth and senior national representatives utilised by the entire Central European region.

The velodrome premises will also offer the possibility of use for other sports or social events, with facilities that include parking. Property issues for the premises have been resolved and it is ready for realisation of the project.

CAMPUS ATHLETICS HALL

The construction of the new athletics hall is the result of years of searching for a solution to the plight of athletics in Brno, the clubs' lack of facilities, especially for preparation in the winter months.

The memorandum between the Czech Athletics Federation, the City of Brno and Masaryk University is a prerequisite for meeting the technical criteria for the construction and future optimal use of the hall.



According to the study the building will house a 200 m long running oval with six lanes, eight lanes for sprinting in the straight sectors and technical disciplines - long jump, triple jump, high jump, pole vault and shot put. The surfaces of the athletics tracks and sectors, including warm-up straights, will meet IAAF rules. The hall is designed with enough space for athletes, referees and spectators and broadcasting technology and the necessary operational and technical equipment. The facilities of the athletics hall are complemented by additional warm-up and recovery areas for athletes.

There are also plans to build an outdoor athletics centre, which will adjoin the campus athletics hall.

The athletics centre will contain a 200 m outdoor running oval - 3 track widths of 1.2 m, running straight with a length of at least 115 m, a sector for long jump and triple jump, a sector for high jump inside the athletics track, a sector for shot put and a multi-purpose pitch for ball games.

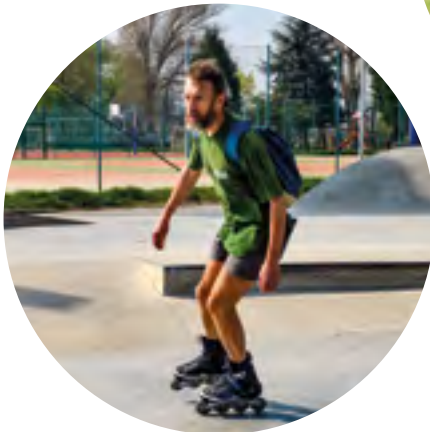
The athletics oval will be complemented with an area for recreational sports and non-traditional sports activities (crossfit, workouts, parkour, outdoor climbing, etc.) and a fitness area. The estimated cost of the outdoor part is 20 mil. CZK.

ANTHROPOS SPORTS-RECREATION AREA

The area in question is located in the city district of Brno-centre in the cadastral area of Pisárky, and has an area of approximately 13.5 ha. The territory has a large sports and recreational potential for use by the citizens of Brno.

LUŽÁNKY CITY SWIMMING STADIUM

AQUAPARK

The building of an outdoor terraced complex was planned already in the sixties.

The current Aquapark project is divided into covered and outdoor swimming pools and other recreational areas.



The covered part of the complex is designed to provide the illusion of a romantic tropical lagoon with attractions in the space graduated by the degree of adventurousness.

Outdoor areas with the natural character swimming in and staying by a river or lake will be in operation in the extended summer season, thanks to the hot water in the lagoon.

The City of Brno is looking for a private investor for the realisation of this project.

25-METRE POOL

The construction of another pool in the premises of the Lužánky City Swimming Stadium is necessary due to increased demand for organised swimming and swimming for the public.

The new water area will also serve as a warm-up pool, which is a condition for holding international swimming competitions. For these reasons, an essential factor is building sufficiently wide lanes, as is the case with the existing 50-metre swimming pool.

To construct the new pool use will be made of the spaces of the former 16-metre pool, rowing simulator and the space below the unused small park at the main entrance to the building of the stadium.

PISÁRKY WILD WATER CHANNEL

The site for the construction of the watercourse was selected as an area near the river Svatka in the former Pisárky water treatment plant, which compared to other locations, has a great advantage in having the Kamenný mlýn drop weir, making it possible to save the cost of building and operating it.

The complex is designed as a multi-purpose one with the main use for training and competitions in water slalom with parameters that correspond to the possibilities of organising international competitions and are comparable with the channel in Prague-Trója.

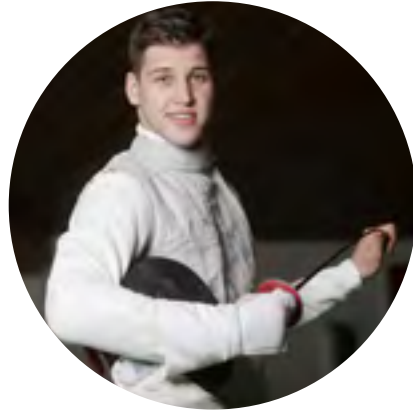
The watercourse is expected to be used for training and rodeo water racing and rafting disciplines, for water rescue training for FRS interventions during flooding.

The complex will also include a 900 m long asphalt trail for in-line skating, jogging and walks.




